ABSENTEE BALLOTS, PART 3

If you're currently a Travis County resident, you can download an ABBM application here: https://countyclerk.traviscounty.gov/wp-content/uploads/elections/pdfs/ballot_by_mail/ABBM-APP-11-30.pdf and complete it and mail it in to get your ABBM sent to you.

Ballots are mailed out 30 to 45 days before an election or 7 days after the county election office receives an application. When you receive your ballot, be sure to:

- Mark your ballot using a black or blue pen
- Place your ballot in the ballot envelope and seal it
- Place the ballot envelope in the carrier envelope
- You MUST fill in your ID information (drivers license, social security last 4) and it is advised to also fill in the blanks for telephone number and email. This is a new step and is found on the flap of the carrier envelope that you must lick in two places
- Seal carrier envelope and sign where indicated exactly as you signed the application for ballot by mail.

Students living away at school, check the "address outside the county" box. After you've mailed your application you can monitor your absentee ballot status at www.votetexas.gov. Click Track My Ballot. NOTE: Your absentee ballot application must be received (not postmarked) by OCTOBER 28, 2022, for the November 8, 2022 election. Plan on mailing your ABBM in by October 15th so it arrives by the 28th.



IMPORTANT! In Texas your completed absentee ballot application **MUST** include your Texas Driver's license number OR the last four digits of your Social Security Number, AND your Voter Unique Identification Number (VUID) shown on your Voter Registration Card. Read the absentee ballot application carefully to provide these numbers.
